

Announcement Concerning The St. Paul, Minnesota Courthouse
and Operation of the Eighth Circuit's St. Paul Clerk's Office

The Warren E. Burger Federal Courthouse in St. Paul, Minnesota is scheduled to undergo an extensive renovation project beginning in October, 2005. While the completion date for the project is not yet known, the renovations will take a minimum of 20 months. In order to facilitate the project, the courthouse is being closed, and all of the current occupants, including the Eighth Circuit's Divisional Clerk's Office, are being moved to new locations.

The St. Paul Divisional Clerk's Office will move out of its current location in the Federal Courthouse on Friday, September 30, 2005, and will reopen for business in its new location at 8:00 a.m. on Monday, October 3, 2005.

The Divisional Clerk's Office will continue to perform its case processing functions at the new location.

However, because the court does not have access to suitable court room space, the court will not be able to conduct its regular St. Paul court sessions until the renovation is completed. A panel of the court will sit at St. Thomas Law School in November, 2005 and March, 2006. Counsel scheduled for arguments at those law school sessions will be notified when the calendars are published. Arguments in most cases from the northern states of the circuit will be set in St. Louis, Missouri. The court regrets any inconvenience these arrangements may cause counsel and litigants.
