
In re Complaint of John Doe<sup>1</sup>

This is a judicial complaint filed by an inmate (“complainant”) against a now-retired United States district judge who was originally assigned to the inmate’s § 1983 lawsuit.

The judicial complaint must be dismissed because the complained-of judge is now retired and is no longer a covered judge. *See* Judicial-Conduct and Judicial-Disability Proceedings of the Judicial Conference of the United States (J.C.U.S.) Rule 1(b).

Accordingly, the judicial complaint is dismissed.
