This is a judicial complaint filed by a criminal defendant (“complainant”) against a now-retired United States magistrate judge.

The now-retired magistrate judge is not a “covered judge” subject to the Judicial Conduct and Disability Act, 28 U.S.C. §§ 351–365. *See* Judicial-Conduct and Judicial-Disability Proceedings of the Judicial Conference of the United States (J.C.U.S.) Rule 1(b).

The judicial complaint is dismissed.
